## National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) (Ministry of Road Transport & Highways) Government of India

## Letter of Invitation for National/International Agencies

1. The National Highways Authority of India (the "Authority") is engaged in the development of National Highways and as part of this endeavor, the Authority has decided to undertake development and operation/ maintenance of the Personal Rapid Transit (PRT) system Delhi-Gurgaon Pilot Project Corridor (Length: 12.30 kms) from Km 24.00 at NH-8 (Delhi Haryana Border) – Km 33.50 (Rajiv Chowk, Gurgaon) – NH-248A Sohna Road Project (the "Project") through Public-Private Partnership (the "PPP") on Design, Build, Finance, Operate and Transfer (the "DBFOT") basis, and decided to carry out the bidding process for selection of a private entity as the bidder to whom the Project may be awarded on the basis of evaluation of their respective system in the Pilot test run projects of about 1 Km length to be developed by Bidders. In case of more than 1 technology is found to be suitable, more stretches can be identified for pilot project in such a way that each one of them can be further extended to a reasonable length, if the technology is successful in the pilot stretch. The pilot project is to be executed by the bidder at their own risk and cost. A brief description of the project may be seen in the Information Memorandum of the Project at the Authority's website www.nhai.org

The purpose of NHAI undertaking PRT System is to "Regulate and control the plying of Vehicles on selected pilot stretch of National Highways vested with NHAI".

The Authority intends to pre-qualify suitable Applicants (the "Bidders") who will be eligible for participation in the Bid Stage, for awarding the Project through evaluation of pilot projects based on the parameters provided by the "Bidders" and performance in the test run section.

Considering the capability and efficiency of Private sector, NHAI desires to join hand through Public-Private Partnership (the "PPP") with the entrepreneurs that have valid rights and capabilities to Design, Build, Finance, & Operate PRT systems in India. Accordingly, NHAI invites Expression of Interest (EOI) from entrepreneurs for development of these facilities through physical submission of applications to the HO Delhi office of NHAI and online submission on e-procurement portal <a href="http://etenders.gov.in">http://etenders.gov.in</a>. downloaded from NHAI website (<u>www.nhai.org</u>) as well as the online e- procurement portal <u>http://etenders.gov.in</u>.

Sealed physical applications must reach the concerned project office of NHAI on or before 13.03.2018 (upto 1100 Hrs IST). Online applications must also be submitted on the e- procurement portal at <a href="http://etenders.gov.in">http://etenders.gov.in</a>. Both physical and online submissions are mandatory and the application may be rejected in case any of the physical or online submission is not made in the stipulated time.

The shortlisted bidders, who is either a company incorporated under the Companies Act, 1956 or undertakes to incorporate as such prior to execution of the concession agreement (the "Concessionaire") shall be responsible for designing, engineering, financing, procurement, construction, operation and maintenance of the Project under and in accordance with the provisions of a long term concession agreement (the "Concession Agreement") to be entered into between the Concessionaire and the Authority in the form provided by the Authority as part of the Bidding Documents pursuant hereto.
